Alarms

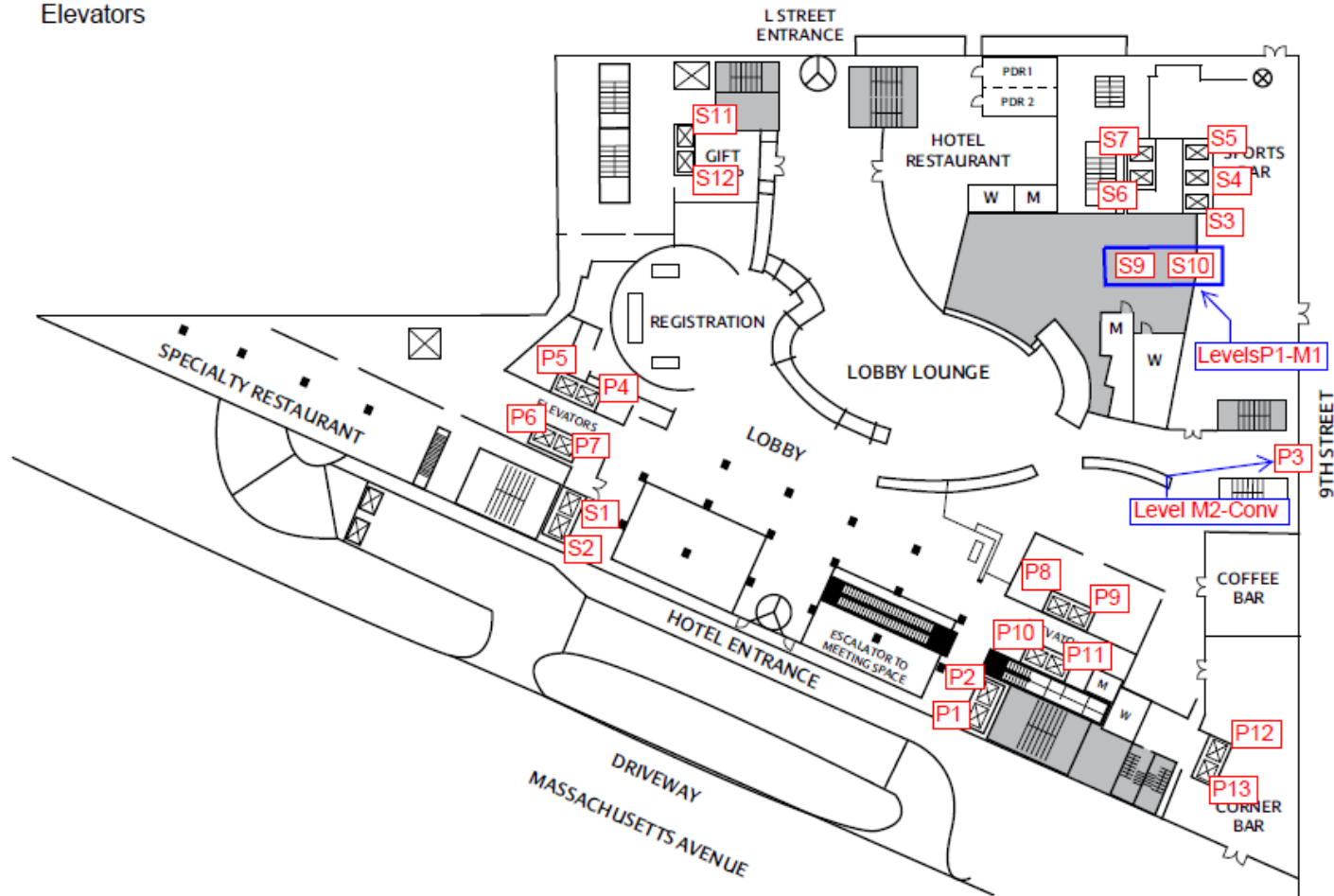


- **Fire Alarm Activation**
 - Alert Signal: Strobe lights will flash and an announcement will advise "Fire Emergency Please Evacuate by the Nearest Exit"
- **Evacuation Activation**
 - Alert Signal: Strobe lights will flash and an announcement will advise to "Evacuate the Building by the Nearest Exit"
- **Non Emergency Alarms**
 - In the event that the Hotel experiences a non emergency alarm, all guests should stand by in their areas and wait for instructions which will be broadcasted throughout the Hotel on the Public Address System.
 - If we need to evacuate, the Hotel Emergency Response Team will guide you to the nearest exit.

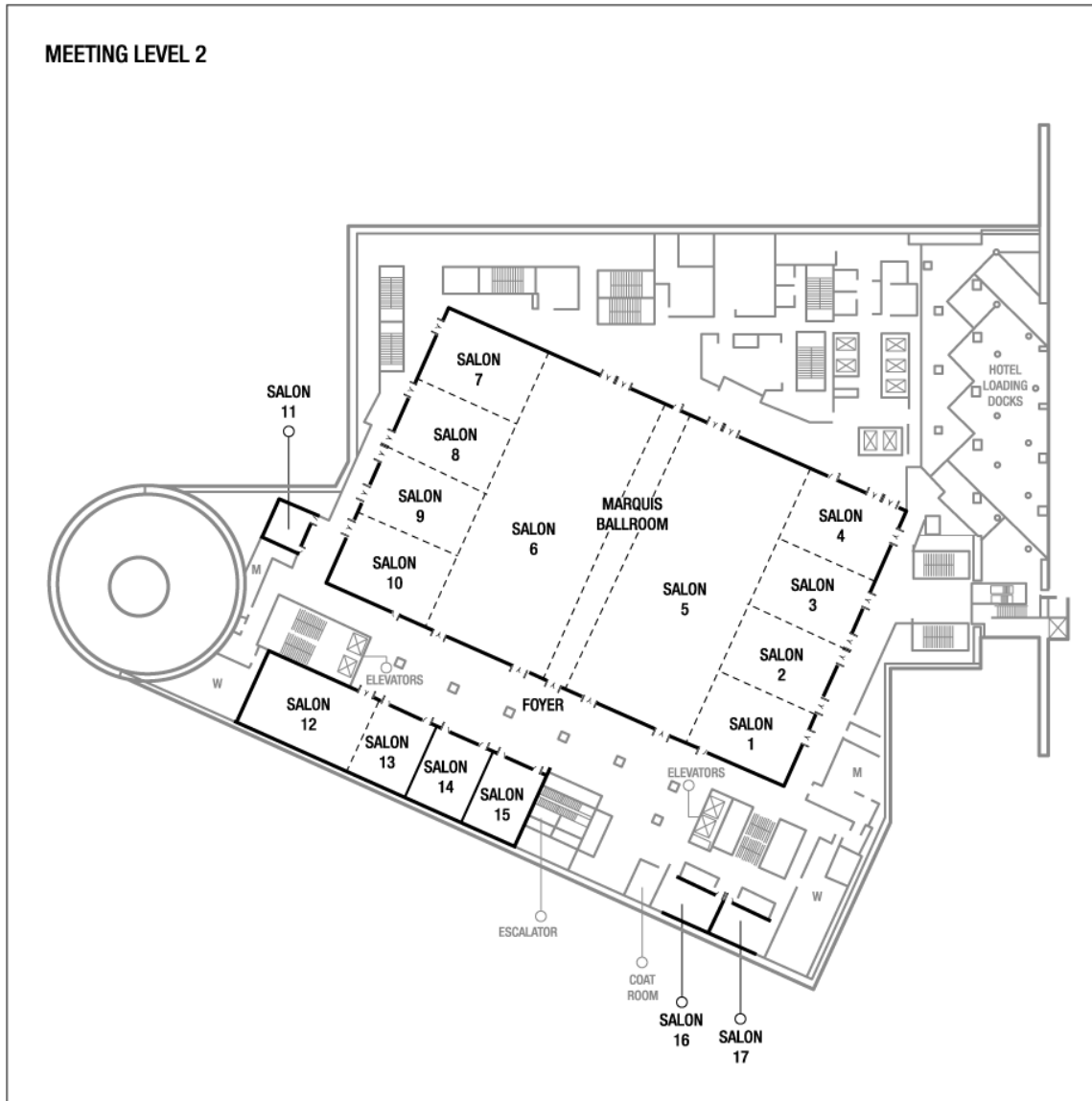

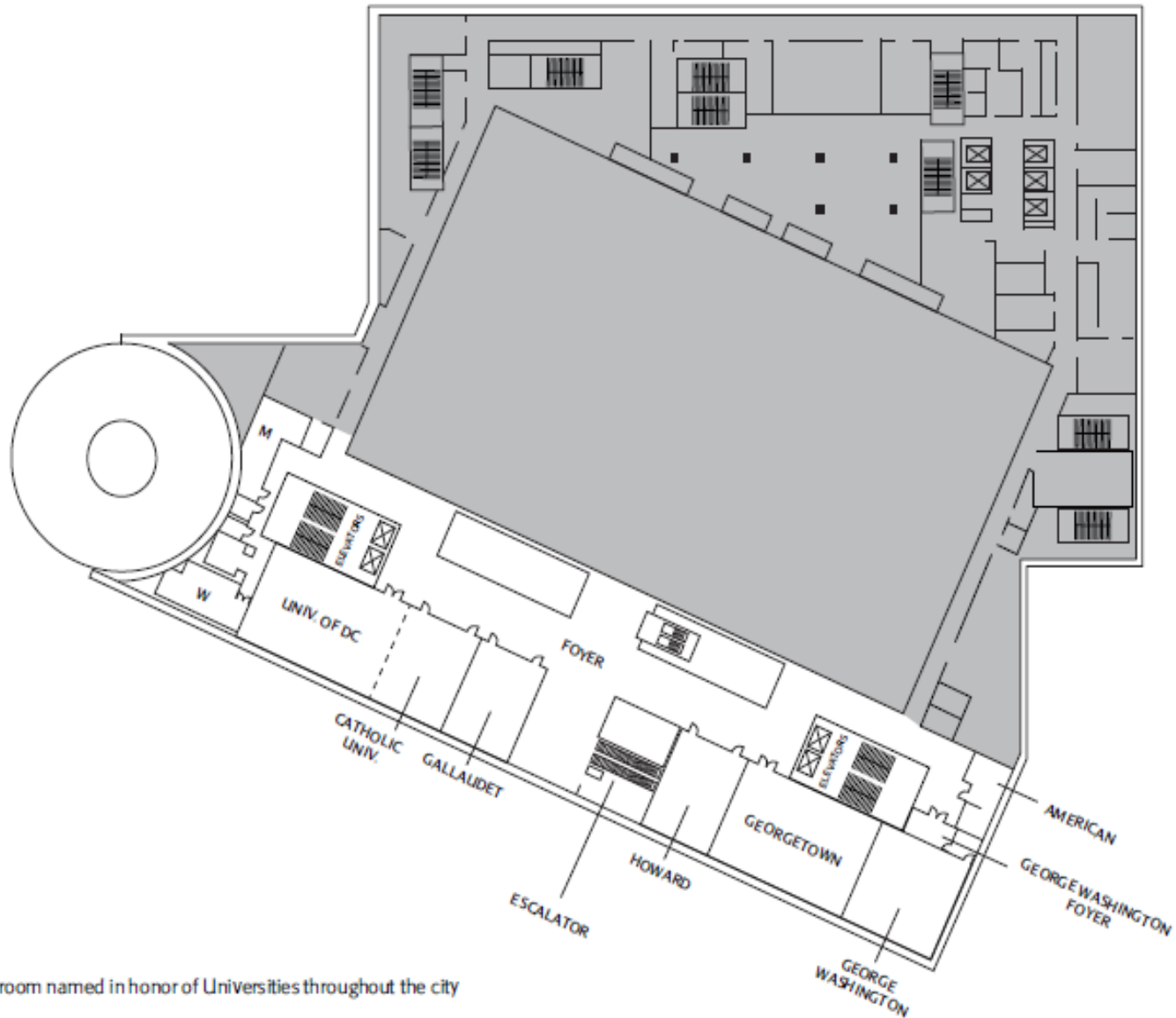

Meeting Level 2 (M2)

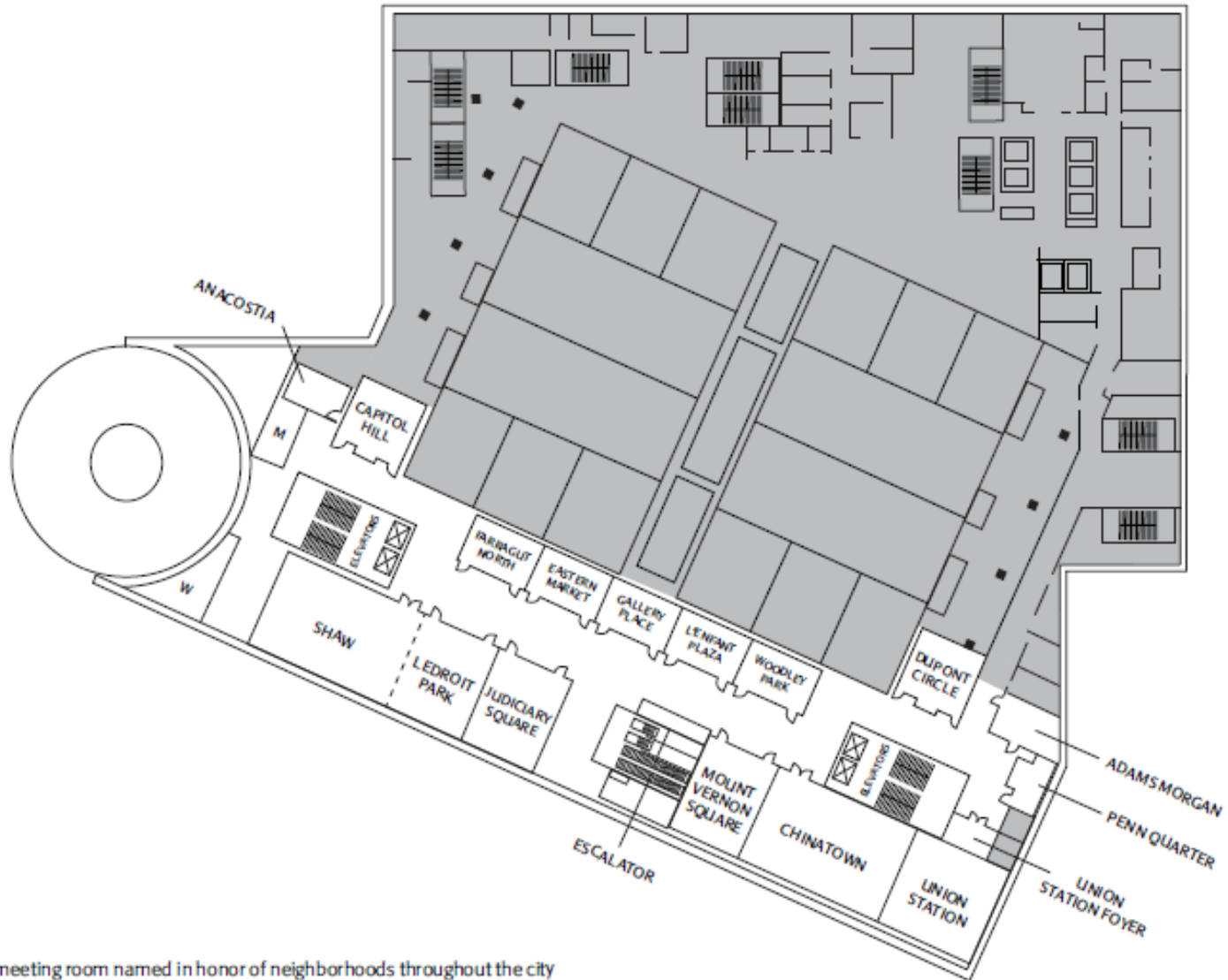
MEETING LEVEL 2
